## THE NEXT GENERATION TEXT SERVICE



#### What is the Next Generation Text Service?

The Next Generation Text (NGT) Service is a free service which enables users of standard voice telephone to communicate with users of TextPhones and vice versa. When you place a call using the NGT service, you are connected via a Text Relay Assistant. Their job is to read the text side of the conversation to the voice phone user and transcribe the voice phone user's speech into a TextPhone.

#### Making a call to a TextPhone

To make a call to a number that may be answered by a TextPhone, simply dial:



Note that there may be a slight delay until a Text Relay Assistant becomes available. During this time, the voice user will hear a recorded message stating:



If the call is answered by a voice telephone, the call will bypass the NGT Service and you can talk with the person who has answered. If at any point the call is switched from a voice telephone to a TextPhone, then it will automatically attempt to route through the NGT Service. There may be a

slight delay until a relay assistant is available. You will hear the same recorded message.

### Receiving a call from a TextPhone

As all voice telephones are capable of receiving calls via the NGT Service, you could potentially receive a call using this service.

If someone dials you from a TextPhone using this service, when you answer, you will hear a recorded message stating:

Once a Text Relay Assistant is available, they will advise you that you have received a call from a D/deaf or speech impaired person and that they will be relaying the call.



### **During the call**

When you have finished speaking and would like the relay assistant to send the message, you must say '**Go ahead**.' If you don't, the relay assistant will assume that you are thinking what else to say and not send the message to the TextPhone.

## **Ending a call**

As the voice phone user, you simply say 'bye' or 'goodbye' which indicates to the relay assistant that you are ending the call.
